Steeped in heritage

Originally a farmhouse, Killeavy Lodge was redesigned into a castellated grand residence for the Foxall family by Dublin architect George Papworth in the 1830's. Taking ownership in 1881 the Bell Family resided for several generations, until it gradually fell into disrepair.

Current owner Mick Boyle, born locally and raised in Australia has restored the Estate to strengthen his strong family ties to the region. Together with his wife Robin and their 4 children, their aim has been to create a special place for the community to gather and celebrate the beauty of South Armagh.





Guided by a conservation architect, the Grade A listed heritage building was meticulously restored to revive all the grandeur of the 1830's Gothic design.

The Estate too has been returned to former glory and is now a working farm with native woodlands beneath Slieve Gullion, once an immense volcano which created this unique Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

For millennia, the mountain has been an important place. Site of Stone Age monuments and of key events in Irish mythology featuring legendary heroes Finn McCool and Cuchulainn.





At one with nature

The environment around us inspires all that we do at Killeavy Castle Estate. Everything has a purpose. We put much thought into what we grow, buy, use and reuse.

We're restocking our woodland with native oak to restore habitat diversity. And creating forest trails to bring you closer to nature. We farm sustainably too. Traditional local breeds of Longhorn cattle and Cheviot sheep graze in our pastures.

Wherever possible, we use fresh ingredients foraged, grown or raised right here, in our fields, forests and extensive Walled and Estate Gardens.

We make our own jams, preserves, and dried foods. We smoke, age and cure our own meat, so that the bounty can be savoured year-round in our Restaurants and Estate Farm Store. Supporting our community, 90% of everything we serve and sell is sourced from within twenty miles.

Even the seaweed adorning those Carlingford oysters ends up fertilising our strawberry plants. And slates have a second life as plates. We're always finding inventive ways to meet our sustainable target goal to be carbon neutral by 2027.
